You are to follow these outline or guidelines for writing your reflection paper:

Who, What, Where, When, Why and How...should all find there way into your paper.

- ✓ Paragraph 1 – Briefly tell the where, what and who of your volunteer experience. (about 3-5 sentences??)
- ✓ Paragraph 2 – elaborate on the people you served or helped. Give specific details about them.
- ✓ Paragraph 3 – elaborate on the work you did. Again, be specific in describing your contribution. What talents (physical, emotional, spiritual, intellectual) did you have to use?
- ✓ Paragraph 4 – explain why and how this experience changed you for the better. (Let's hope it did!) **Be brave here. Dip your pen in your heart.**
- ✓ Paragraph 5 – as a wise, old senior, please share your thoughts on your OVERALL Christian experience at Providence. This closing paragraph can address just the A.C.T.S. hours you did all four years. Or, if you so choose, you could give your thoughts on a combination of any of the following: IALAC, your one day retreats, class prayer, all school prayer, all school Masses, Kairos, and the A.C.T.S. program.
