

The Celtics defeated the Mustangs of Mundelein High School 10-3 at Silver Cross Field in Joliet on June 11. This is the first time in Illinois high school history that a varsity baseball team has achieved a three-peat. Providence Catholic will now have 30 State Championship banners hanging in the Sacred Heart Gym, the most winning private high school in the State of Illinois! NEW STUDENT & PARENT PORTALS FOR 16-17

After June 30, Providence Catholic will no longer use Edline as our parent-student portal. We will be replacing it with ParentPlus and StudentPlus. These new portals are fully integrated with our student information system and gradebook. They enable teachers to share data and school/course information with you instantly. The mobile apps for both iOS and Android will make it easy for you to stay connected as well.

In early July, all parents will receive an email containing login credentials for ParentPlus. Included in that email will be links to tutorials, user guides and the mobile apps. Please be aware that parents will create individual accounts and each parent must have a <u>unique</u> email address in order to receive login credentials. Parents cannot use the same email address. If we do not have your current email addresses, please contact Ms. Melissa Muehler at (815) 717-3143 or via email at <u>mmuehler@providencecatholic.org</u>.

FAMILY INFORMATION FORMS

In early July, the primary parent of each family will receive an email regarding filling out the "Family Information Form." The email will contain a link to a secure site, where you will be asked to verify and update your students' information, including medical and emergency information. This form is just one of the requirements needed to receive a student schedule and book sale admittance number. Please be aware that the email will be sent only to the primary parent, which you indicated last year when completing this form.



BYOD PROGRAM CONTINUES NEXT YEAR

During the 16-17 school year all freshmen will be required to BYOD, or "Bring Your Own Device." They will have their laptop/tablets during the entire school day for educational use. At the same time, teachers of sophomores, juniors and seniors will be "in training mode." They will be implementing more class activities and lessons that incorporate the use of those devices. Although we currently

have laptops for classroom use, all sophomores, juniors and seniors are highly encouraged to BYOD next year. In addition to classroom activities, students can also use the laptop for note-taking and organization.

Remember that a smartphone is <u>not</u> an acceptable device, since it does not meet our minimum specifications. Students may use their phones ONLY with the permission of the classroom teacher.

During the 17-18, all students will be required to BYOD. Learn more about our BYOD program on our website, **paying special attention to the Minimum Specifications and FAQ sections**. MICROSOFT OFFICE FOR STUDENT DEVICE

As families purchase devices required for our BYOD program, we want to make families aware of a benefit for all students which will save you money! Microsoft's *Student Advantage* is part of our volume license agreement. As such, all PCHS students are eligible for the following:

- The latest versions of Microsoft Word, Excel, PowerPoint, OneNote, Outlook, Access and Publisher
- Installation on up to five PCs or Macs, and the Office apps on other mobile devices including Windows tablets and iPad
- One Terabyte of OneDrive cloud storage
- Office Online



We will assist students with installation of the software during the first week of the 2016-2017 school year. Also during those first weeks, the Technology Staff will conduct training sessions for other BYOD-related tasks such as connecting to the Wi-Fi, logging in to the network and internet filter and more. In the meantime, please do not purchase Microsoft Office or attempt to install the software on your own.

At any time, you can click on the Search icon in the upper right corner, and then type in some keywords to find the information you need.


The search tool is also included in each mega-menu.

You can also click on "Home", which is included in the "breadcrumbs" above the header of each page.




MOBILE VIEW
