<u>MIDWEST AUGUSTINIANS TO CELEBRATE</u> <u>The service of Fr. John Merkelis, O.S.A.</u>

The Midwest Augustinian Province invites the community of Providence Catholic High School to join us in celebrating the extraordinary service of Fr. John Merkelis O.S.A.. At the Fifth Annual Augustinian Gala, on Friday, April 27, 2018, the Augustinian friars, friends, and benefactors will gather at the Drake Hotel in downtown Chicago to recognize the contribution of Fr. Merkelis to Providence Catholic and the larger Midwest Province. Fr. Merkelis will be joined by fellow honorees Br. Jerome Sysko, O.S.A., and Augustinian Affiliates Tony and Phyllis Lauinger.

Fr. Merkelis was ordained to the Augustinian priesthood in 1985 and first assigned to Immaculate Conception/St. Henry Parish in St. Louis, MO. In 1988, he became Director

of Pastoral Ministry at Providence Catholic, where he was named Principal in 1994. He was assigned to Saint Jude Parish, New Lenox, Illinois, in 1999 and was appointed Director of Vocations for the Augustinian Province of Our Mother of Good Counsel.

Father Merkelis' term as Director of Vocations ended in June, 2006. He was assigned to Saint John of Sahagún Friary at Providence Catholic High School, New Lenox, in August, 2006. He was again appointed Director of Pastoral Ministry in the school.

PREPARING FOR THE 2018-2019 SCHOOL YEAR

FINANCIAL AID

Please watch for Fr. McGrath's letter which will be mailed to your home next week. Read the letter carefully. Families are encouraged to file their income tax early in order to meet the deadline. This **online** form is **very important**. Both the Providence Endowment Aid and the Joliet Diocesan Aid program use this form to determine the amount of Providence Catholic tuition grants for the next school year.

PRE-PAYMENT RESERVATIONS

For students who will be sophomores, juniors or seniors in the next school year, the **pre-payment reservation deadline is Wednesday, January 17, 2018.** Parents of all students must return the Pre-Payment form with a down payment of \$100 per student by **January 17th**, in order to be assured of a place at Providence Catholic next year. The \$100 prepayment is applied towards next year's tuition. We ask that the form be returned by this date so we can begin to schedule students with accuracy for the 2018-2019 school year. Please do not include the pre-payment in your regular tuition payment. Prepay forms will be included with Fr. McGrath's Financial Aid letter.

STUDENT SCHEDULING & COURSE REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

As Providence Catholic continues our efforts to go paperless, students will be registering for next-year's classes through the Student Portal. Counselors will meet with students in their English classes to guide them through the selfregistration process using their devices to access the Student Portal on our Portal Plus system. Following your student's registration, parents will view, approve, and submit course selections electronically through the Parent Plus Portal. Parents will be emailed specific and detailed instructions during the week of registration.

BYOD REMINDERS



A common problem for students is laptop battery life. Students should charge their laptops every night! Please remind your students about various ways to conserve battery life. Here is <u>one article</u> about maximizing battery power on Windows laptops. <u>This article is one for Macbooks</u>.

Students are **<u>required</u>** to have a second power adapter that is kept here at

school. We have secure charging lockers in the hallways and surge protectors in the classrooms where students can plug in. But they need a power adapter to do so! (Santa says this would make a great stocking stuffer!)

Unfortunately, we have seen a lot of cracked screens and other damage to student laptops. Most of this is caused by a drop. We know that accidents will happen. We tell students to close their laptops and place it on the seat of their desks

when they need to get up. This can prevent accidental bumps and drops. We <u>require</u> students to have a protective sleeve for carrying the laptop during the school day. Some examples can be found <u>here at Amazon.com</u>.

Our Wi-Fi was updated at the end of October and connectivity is greatly improved! Your student should not be using his/her cell phone as a hotspot. (If you are seeing an increase in data usage on your cell phone bill, that may be why.) This circumvents our network and internet filtering and as such is disallowed per our <u>Responsible Use Policy</u>.

Lastly, please encourage your students to come to the Tech Office for assistance. In most cases, students just need to know how to troubleshoot a problem or perform a simple fix. We are happy to help! Tech Office hours are 7:15 a.m. – 3:15 p.m. when school is in session. The Tech Office is located in Computer Lab 1.

SENIOR ACTS INFORMATION

A gentle reminder to parents of our senior students: The "A Call to Serve Program" (A.C.T.S.) is another opportunity for our students to practice our Faith. The primary focus of ACTS is to bring the message of Jesus Christ to life by providing an experience of Christian service in the everyday world. This service is one of our graduation requirements. After performing his/her twenty-five hours of service, the senior student is asked to submit an evaluation from an onsite supervisor and a personal reflection paper. <u>Guidelines for these can be found on the PCHS webpage</u>. You can also find instructions and forms on your SharePoint page under A.C.T.S. Hours. Do not forget to fill out the pre-approval form for each service project that you complete. Opportunities for service that come to the school's attention are put in the daily announcements. There is, also, an ACTS bulletin board in the cafeteria where opportunities are posted. Both the Adult On-site Evaluation(s) – (for the total of hours) and the two-page Reflection Paper (paper-clipped or stapled together) will be collected in the seniors' Theology classes. 8TH GRADE PLACEMENT EXAM, SATURDAY, 12/2/17

Arrive by 7:45 a.m.; Test begins at 8:00 a.m.

All current 8th graders who would like to be considered for admission to Providence Catholic as freshmen in the fall of 2018 must take this exam on Saturday, December 2, 2018. Below is important information about this day:

- Pre-registration is required and can be done on the Placement Exam page of our website beginning November 18th
- Students should arrive between 7:30 a.m. 7:45 a.m.
- The test fee is \$25.00. Cash or check (made payable to PCHS, are accepted.)
- Please bring two #2 pencils.
- Calculators are not permitted for the test.
- If you are a Providence Catholic family and have an 8th grade student, they must take the placement day on this day to be considered for admission.

NEW Scholarship Opportunities for the Class of 2022!

Providence Catholic has implemented a new academic scholarship program that will tremendously impact the incoming freshman (Class of 2022). By taking the placement exam on December 2, 2017, your student may qualify for the following scholarships. Below is a breakdown of the scholarship awards based on where your student scores on the placement exam:

Celtic Scholar Award: Score 90%-94% = \$6,000 (\$1,500 per year at PCHS). Must maintain a 3.25 GPA.

<u>Celtic Scholar with Distinction Award</u>: Score 95%-99% = \$10,000 (\$2,500 per year at PCHS). Must maintain a 3.5 GPA.

We want to thank parents, students, and alumni for spreading the word about the placement exam and Providence Catholic. Your efforts have a huge effect on persuading eighth graders and their families that our value laden environment is the answer to their needs. BAD WEATHER POLICIES & ARRANGEMENTS

All parents are aware that freezing temperatures may be dangerous to students who must wait in the cold. It is up to the **individual** parent to determine whether or not their student's health is at risk when the cold is intense. **School will always be held at Providence Catholic when extremely cold temperature is the <u>only</u> hazard to traveling. When there is snow on the ground, or it is snowing, or there is a threat of snow, and Providence Catholic decides to close school, we will use the Notify system. If a snow schedule is in effect, school will begin one hour later** and the buses will run **one hour later** to allow snowplows to open roads. This will be conveyed through the Notify system. School will be in session whenever the school buses can run safely. The Notify system will be the main method of notifying school closings or emergency notifications, but you may also do any of the following: Check the PCHS Website and all official Providence Catholic social media pages; listen to any of the following radio stations: WMAQ 67 (AM), WGN 720 (AM), WLS 890 (AM), B 96 (FM), WLS 94.7 (FM), WBBM 78 (AM), and locally WJOL 1340 (AM); call the PCHS Emergency Closing line at (815) 717-3131.
