Please accept our sincere gratitude to families and patrons for your generous contributions to this year's Harvest Drive, which has generated more than \$315,000, exceeding our goal of \$300,000. All

proceeds from the Harvest Drive are applied to the school's operating expenses.

Patrons may still support Harvest Drive by <u>purchasing an ad listing</u> through October 31. All late money will be credited toward each family's minimum obligation, but will not be applied toward student prize incentives.

Congratulations to M. Minnis who was the \$10,000 grand prize winner, A. Drew (\$2,000 1st prize) and J. McClarance (\$1,000 2nd prize).
