Dear AP Students and Parents,

College Board has released their next round of updates regarding the Advanced Placement Testing. I have highlighted the major points for you. **I cannot stress enough the importance of completing the online assignments and watching the online videos that are being produced to help prepare you for the AP exams.** I know that the first videos cover information that will not be on the exam but as they explain in the videos they are required to cover all of the material to ensure to the colleges that all of the material has been covered for the class to receive the college credit. They have stated that they will be getting to some good review information.

Here is a summary of the updates:

- Exam Dates will now be May 11th-22nd.
- Tests will be taken at the same time worldwide either at home or in schools (if in session).
- Exams will consist of one to two free response questions and can be taken on a computer, cell phone or tablet.
- AP will provide resources for those that need them if they reach out by April 24th. If you need assistance please visit <https://collegeboard.tfaforms.net/74> and complete the form.
- Colleges have expressed that they will accept the tests as valid and scores should be released in July including specifically the University of California system and Yale.
- Teachers will receive the students' responses to test questions by May 26th.
- They are taking exam security very seriously and will report issues to schools including any colleges they applied to and prevent them from taking any AP exams and SAT tests in the future.
