### GENERAL INFORMATION

#### **NATURE OF TESTS**

The five written tests (Language Arts, Social Studies, Science, Mathematics and Geography) will be multiple choice questions intended to challenge above average seventh and eighth grade students. Each written exam will have 50 multiple choice questions. After the students have finished the exams there will be an opportunity to review the answers while their tests are being graded. Seventh and eighth grade students will take separate tests.

Students will not be allowed to use calculators or devices on any of the Academic Bowl tests.

#### **TIEBREAKERS FOR INDIVIDUAL TROPHIES**

If two or more students have the same score on a written test and are in competition for an individual trophy, the tie will be decided on procedures set forth by the Academic Bowl Committee.

#### **TIEBREAKERS FOR TEAMS**

If two or more teams have the same composite score and are in competition for a team trophy the team whose top three scores equal the greatest sum will be designated the winner of the trophy in question. If this tiebreaker does not settle the issue, the team whose top two scores equal the greatest sum will be designated the winner. If this does not break the tie, the team whose top score is higher will be designated the winner.

#### **ALTERNATES**

All participants, whether an individual or team member, are eligible to compete for individual trophies. The alternate's scores will not count towards team awards or scores. The purpose of the alternate is to be the back up participant if the team participant cannot compete on the day of the competition. **Also, the alternate can score in the top five of an individual test preventing another school's team participant from finishing in the top five. This adds an element of strategy to the team competition for each school.**

#### **ELECTRONIC DEVICES**

Students are not allowed to use devices on any test. If a student has a device, it will be collected in the classroom at the beginning of testing and returned upon completion.

#### **REGISTRATION**

This year, registration will be conducted online from a link at our school web page at
