We hope you are having an enjoyable summer. We are busy preparing for the upcoming school year. One of those tasks is to prepare your student for BYOD. This email contains information about registering your student for one of our BYOD Setup Sessions.

Each new student is required to attend one session. Each session is 3 ½ hours long. Sessions are limited to 35 students each. PCHS faculty and NHS students will show students how to attach to our Wi-Fi, install Microsoft Office, activate their StudentPlus account and more. It is necessary that your student has these skills before the school year starts. All freshmen will receive additional training during their Introduction to Technology class.
