



SEMESTER EXAM INFORMATION: GOLD COHORT

MAY 24TH, 25TH, 26TH & 27TH (MORNING 7:55 A.M. – 10:10 A.M.)

Final examinations will be administered to students on May 24th, 25th, 26th, & 27th. Two exams are scheduled per day; each exam will last 55-minutes, with a 15-minute break between tests.

ALL ONLINE LEARNERS (FULL-TIME OR TEMPORARY) WILL TAKE ALL FINAL ASSESSMENTS ONLINE AT THE SAME TIME AS THEIR IN-PERSON CLASSMATES.

In order to continue with the safety measures put in place, students can only begin arriving at certain times prior to their exams. In the event your student is exempt from taking a certain exam, he/she may arrive late to school or leave school early on that day. Those times are included in the table below.
