Dear AP Students and Parents,

On Friday, College Board has decided that they are going to move forward with AP testing after feedback from students indicating that they still want the opportunity for college credit. There are some adjustments to the testing. Below, I have summarized some the announcements that they have made. I have also included links to two College Board web pages that have or will have helpful information for you about what will be on the test, the test dates and the resources College Board is providing to help you prepare for the tests. I will have more information for you by April 3rd.

What has been adjusted by College Board?

1. Students will take a 45-minute online exam at home on any device with internet access.
2. They are creating two test dates for each subject for students to choose.
 - a. An early date for students who want to get it done while information is still fresh in their head.
 - b. A later date for students who want more time to prepare.
3. The content on the exams will cover material that should have been covered through early March in class or roughly 75% of the class content.
4. Starting March 25th, College Board is continuing to support students with free resources through exam day including daily online review sessions delivered by AP teachers from across the country.
5. Information about the reduced scope of content that will be covered on each 2020 AP Exam is currently posted on AP Central. The specific test dates and the free-response question types will all be posted by April 3.
