One of our most treasured memories is the Mother's Mass, with the accompanying memories that we are blessed to have at Providence Catholic! I want to extend a personal invitation to attend this Thursday, May 2<sup>nd</sup> at 11:15 a.m. There is a special schedule that day, and all students will be dismissed immediately after Mass, at approximately 1:00 p.m.

Our attendance at this Mass has increased over the past several years, so we have implemented a format which will allow us to accommodate families in a more comfortable way. The sophomores, juniors and seniors will be seated in the bleachers of the large gym; guests will be seated on the main floor. The freshman class will be seated in the small gym, and the Mass will be televised on large screens placed in the small gym. For mothers who only have a freshman student, seating will be available either in the small gym behind the freshman class or in the large gym.

You may park in the eastern parking lot (the concrete lot where the students usually park), or the lot directly behind the commons. Special needs parking is provided directly behind the commons, closest to the school. Students will be assigned to guide you to available parking. When you arrive, you may enter through Doors #4, #13 or #14.

Per tradition, the Women's Club is requesting potted flowers to adorn the altar. If you would like to bring potted flowers, please arrive a little early to make sure they are included at the altar.
