Faith & Spirituality

Led by the Pastoral Department, we foster the spiritual, intellectual, emotional, and social growth of our school community. We care for others via our *A Call to Serve* program, through many outreach projects, and as members of our various youth ministries.

We are steeped in prayer! A Mass is offered in the chapel before classes every day. Each morning, we join together during the all-school prayer. All class periods begin with prayer, and the school day ends in prayer. All-school liturgical celebrations occur at least once a month and include Masses, penance services, and retreats.

Students are required to take four years of Theology. As a graduation requirement, each student participates in a school-sponsored retreat annually; Seniors attend Kairos. Faculty and staff participate in a *Day of Renewal* each spring. The Pastoral Department also offers pastoral counseling, sacramental preparation, and vocational guidance.

About Providence Catholic

Providence Catholic High School is a Joliet Diocesan Catholic, coeducational, secondary school administered by the Order of St. Augustine. Building on 100+ years of tradition and academic and co-curricular excellence, the school provides 770 young men and women with an excellent educational experience. We are located in New Lenox, Illinois, on a 75-acre campus approximately 40 miles southwest of Chicago. Students come from over seventy elementary, middle, and junior high schools within a thirty-mile radius.

Providence Catholic has a long history of developing every student's unique potential for learning. We provide each with a four-year college preparatory course of study. Gifted academic students are challenged via AP and honors courses. Students with documented, mild learning disabilities receive support in our learning resource program. When comparing students' Placement Exam (8th grade) scores to their ACT scores (junior/senior year), over 87% of our students significantly improve their national percentile rankings. The average improvement is over 23%.

We have recently implemented two distinct academic programs: Engineering Science, a program that integrates engineering with science and computer science, and INCubatoredu, which offers students an authentic entrepreneurship experience. Recent campus improvements include the \$6 million Brown Student Commons in 2018. It is a 21,000 square foot addition housing the cafeteria, kitchen, concession stand, and spirit shop. We have just embarked on the \$1.3 million *Campaign of Champions* to update our outdoor athletic facilities.

- Strategic Planning experience, preferably.

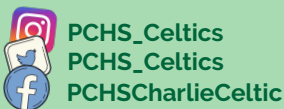
The ideal candidate will be:
