

Senior A.C.T.S. (A Call To Serve)

Information and Guidelines

Overview:

- An opportunity to share God's love with others connected to a graduation requirement

Timeframe:

- Completed service hours, verification forms, reflective essay, and conversation or video reflection due by Tuesday, March 22, 2022

Details:

- At least 25 hours of service completed for the benefit of the Church
 - Up to 5 hours may be completed for helping your family or neighbors during the stay at home order
 - At least 15 hours must be completed for the community outside of Providence Catholic. Up to 10 hours may be completed for the Providence Catholic community.
 - Hours may be completed helping your community at large during the stay at home order. For example, you may sew masks, write letters of encouragement and thanks to healthcare workers or first responders, write letters to residents in nursing homes, help deliver meals, pack care packages or work a drive through food bank
- Service opportunities must be pre-approved by Mr. Oliver. Approval will be requested using a Microsoft Form.

 - Each request will receive an email to approve or deny the request.
- Both the reflective essay and the conversation/video reflection are to be completed on or before Tuesday, March 22, 2022 (early submissions will be greatly appreciated)
- Verification Forms must accompany the Reflective Essay and are to be completed by the responsible adult coordinating your service
- Examples of both acceptable and unacceptable service opportunities will be provided on the A.C.T.S. Hours page.
 - These lists are to serve as a guide to assist in the selection of service opportunities. Students still must receive approval for each opportunity.
