Tips for Setting Up a New Laptop with Windows 11

- During setup, you will be asked to enter a Microsoft account or create a new one. Windows 11 will <u>not</u> allow you to use the student's Providence email account. It must be a consumer Microsoft account. If you don't have one already, we recommend that you create a personal Microsoft account one for your student. When you set up the account, you might want to choose a birthyear of 2005 or earlier; this will help so that the student doesn't always need parental permission to install and use apps on the laptop. It will also prevent Microsoft from asking for credit card information. This is, of course, your choice as a parent. See this page for more about Parental Consent.
- 2. Once you have completed the setup process, uninstall these apps, if they are present. Directions on how to uninstall apps can be found <u>here</u>.
 - a. Microsoft Office
 - b. Microsoft OneNote
 - c. Unless you plan on purchasing a subscription to a third-party anti-virus app such as McAfee, Norton, Avast, etc., uninstall the free trial. In that case, you can use Microsoft Defender. <u>Read</u> <u>more about Microsoft Defender.</u>
- 3. If your Windows operating system is in S mode, you need to switch out in order to install apps.
 - a. Check if you are in S mode
 - b. How to switch out of S mode
- 4. Check for and install Windows updates. Directions are on Microsoft's support site.
- 5. Install your student's copy of Microsoft 365. This will be the desktop versions of Microsoft Word, Excel, PowerPoint, OneDrive, Outlook, etc.
 - a. <u>Read these directions</u> from Microsoft before continuing.
 You will be using a *Work or School account*, not a *Microsoft* account.
 - b. Go to https://www.office.com
 - If it is already logged in, check to see what email account is currently logged in by clicking in the upper right corner., to the right of the ?. If it is NOT your student's school email address, then **sign out**.
 - Login using your <u>student's</u> PCHS email address and password.
 - c. Click on *Install apps* in the upper right. Choose *Microsoft 365 apps*.
 - d. Follow the prompts to complete installation.
- 6. Lastly, go back to our school website and install the Additional required apps.
