2020 AP Testing Guide - This is a long and large document (51 pages) that contains the information need for you to prepare before exam day, the day of the exam and how/when exam scores will be sent out. Please review this document as it covers what devices/browsers you can use to take your exams and what taking exams what the exam experience will be like.

2020 AP Exam Day Checklist - This is a concise document that you can use to organize the information you need to access your test on test day and the steps you will need to follow before, during and after testing.

Explainer Videos: - Here is a link to different video guides to prepare you for the AP Exams this year. I highly recommend watching the 4-minute Exam Walkthrough video as it demonstrates the different ways that you can submit your responses so can start to think about how you plan on doing it on exam day.

On May $4^{\text {th }}$, a clickable AP Exam Demo will become available where you can test your device to ensure that you will be able to use it on exam day.
