SUMMER WORK PROGRAM: Students that apply for financial aid through FACTS Grant and Aid Assessment are encouraged to apply for the 8 week summer work program that begins in June. Approximately ten young men and women work on the school facilities and grounds while supervised by the faculty and staff of Providence Catholic High School. Students receive a salary and are paid as follows: two-thirds is applied to tuition and one-third is given to the students in the form of a direct deposit. Applications are due by March 14.
