## A NOTE FROM DR. HARPER




A week ago, members of the Providence Catholic faculty, staff, and administration joined representatives from other Augustinian high schools located in the United States, Australia, England, and Ireland, in Tulsa, Oklahoma and attended two institutes entitled, "City of God" and "AVI: Augustinian Values Institute." The purpose of these three-day institutes was to equip us with the knowledge and the skills needed so we can better cultivate the ministry of Jesus Christ to our students, and to grow in our love of God and neighbor, the hallmarks of the Augustinian order.

The institute sought to move us away from the selfishness imposed by the "City of Man" and towards the selfless gift of love offered by the "City of God." Through sacred scripture passages, we were challenged to view our work as a decisively pastoral vocation. We were taught, "to elevate the teacher to pastor, is a lifetime of exploring a deeper relationship with God." **REGISTER YOUR CHILD'S BYOD DEVICE:** About a month ago, we emailed the designated primary parent of each family with a link to a form to register student devices with us. Thanks to all those parents who provided the information already! To date, there are still about 60 Freshmen devices that are still unregistered. Our Technology Staff has already returned several devices to students

who left them in classrooms; they used the registration information to track down the owner.

We sent another email on Tuesday 10/4/16 to all freshmen families who have not registered. Please check your inbox or junk mail folder for it. If you have a sophomore, junior or senior and have not yet registered his/her device, please email our registrar Mrs. Laurie Ford to request the form ([Lford@providencecatholic.org](mailto:Lford@providencecatholic.org)).

**QUIKLUNCH PROGRAM:** The QuikLunch program is off to a great start! About half of our students have taken advantage of it, paying for their meals with their ID card. We encourage all of our students to use this system. Remember that if you need to add money to the student account, you have the option of logging in to PayForIt.com where a fee will be charged. Otherwise, you can send a check to PCHS and the amount will be credited without a fee. Checks should be made payable to *Providence Catholic*; please indicate QuikLunch and the student name in the memo. No matter which payment method is used, all parents can login to PayForIt.com to check the balance and see how the students are spending the money on their account.

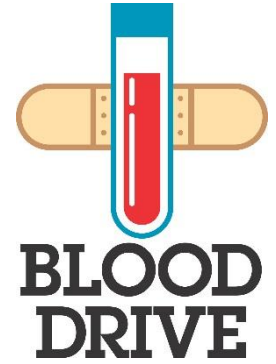

### ALL-SCHOOL TESTING: WEDNESDAY, 10/19

This year Providence Catholic High School will be administering standardized testing on Wednesday, October 19. Attendance is required for all **Freshmen, Sophomores, and Juniors**.

**Seniors** are not in session on that day.

**There will be bus service this day at dismissal. Buses will arrive at 11:45 a.m.**

#### INFORMATION FOR ALL-SCHOOL TESTING

- **Students should arrive by 7:45 am.** All students must be in dress code on testing day.
- **All students** are to have two #2 pencils and an approved calculator. You may NOT use mechanical pencils.



- **All students:** When you have completed your test and are dismissed, you must leave the building. If you are waiting for a ride or for others who ride with you to and from school, you must wait outside of the building or in the cafeteria. If you are a bus rider, busses will be here at 11:45 a.m.

The ACT ASPIRE test will be given to our **Freshmen** and **Sophomores**. The majority of the test will be given on October 19, and will include testing in English, Reading, and Science. Testing in Mathematics will take place on October 26 or 27 during the regularly scheduled Math block. The writing component will be given on November 1 or 2 during the regularly scheduled English block. **Juniors** will take either the PSAT or a retired (practice) ACT on the morning of October 19.

## RED RIBBON WEEK: MONDAY, 10/24-FRIDAY, 10/28

**Red Ribbon Week** is October 24 - October 28, 2016. The Red Ribbon Campaign began in 1985 as a response to the torture and death of federal drug enforcement agent, Enrique Camarena. Wearing and displaying red ribbons are signs that you are against the promotion, sale, purchase and use of illegal drugs or any drug used in an illegal or unhealthy way. This includes the use of alcohol by anyone under the age of 21.

Many departments, clubs and organizations come together to promote this week throughout the Providence Catholic Community. Events for the week include:

- Red ribbon wristband distribution by the Counseling Department on Monday, October 24, 2016.
- Augustinian Youth Ministry (AYM) members will man tables presenting educational information on alcohol and other drugs in the cafeteria during lunches throughout the week.
- Health classes are working on their Alcohol and Other Drugs Unit during this time and will be creating and setting up educational posters in the cafeteria.
- During their Theology classes, all students will hear presentations about the Providence Catholic Student Assistance Program from members of the Student Assistance Team, Fr. Merkelis and Mrs. Annie Persicketti.
