Dear Parents,

You feel it when you walk in the door; it is commonly described as "family." That is what the authors of the above opening paragraph are trying to articulate, and we sure have it here. Being a part of the Providence Catholic family is truly something special.

Your tuition is an investment in your child's future. We are pleased to report that 98% of the Class of 2021 furthered their high school education at colleges and universities. They were offered more than \$47.7 million in scholarships. These positive results underscore the benefits of the financial sacrifice you make on behalf of your child/ren. Our graduates are known throughout the Midwest for being well-rounded young individuals who are prepared to succeed in the challenging academic atmosphere of colleges and universities.

Each year, it is our goal to make every effort to ensure the cost to our families for a Providence Catholic education remains manageable. We estimate next year's actual cost to educate a student at Providence Catholic High School to be approximately \$19,945 per student. The gap between this cost and the amount of tuition and fees received from our families continues to increase. However, through the continued support of our families, alumni, friends, and other stakeholders who believe in our mission, we are trying to close the gap.

After discussion among the Providence Catholic Finance Committee, we have established tuition and fees for the 2022-2023 school year: **tuition will be raised \$400 from \$13,950 to \$14,350.** The discounts for multiple siblings continue to be 10% for the second child and 25% for the third child.

In the coming school year, Providence Catholic will provide more than \$2.8 million dollars to our families in scholarships, discounts and need-based aid. This includes approximately \$2.2 million dollars in direct aid and an additional \$600,000 in discounts for families with multiple children, Catholic elementary discounts, and faculty/staff discounts. Additional programs which help provide assistance include our summer work program and appeals to the Financial

Aid Committee. **If paying tuition is a struggle for your family, please complete the financial aid form online.**

DISCOUNT OFFERED FOR 2022-2023 SCHOOL YEAR: If you pay tuition in full by August 1, 2022, you will receive a \$250.00 discount per student. This discount applies only to tuition and is given only if you have not received any financial aid.

Fees:

Parking: Main Campus parking fee will be \$350.00 for next year.

Activity/Technology Fee: A \$250.00 activity/technology fee is charged for each family. This fee covers accident insurance, student admission to all home games (except for state tournaments), drama and choral productions, the yearbook, the underclass retreat fee, network access and licensing for each student.

Classroom Fees: Classroom fees depend on the courses your child is taking in the academic program.

Senior Fees: There is a \$175.00 fee for all seniors to cover the cost of graduation expenses. The Kairos retreat fee is \$350.00: this fee includes three nights food and lodging, transportation and supplies. Kairos will be held at the Bellarmine Jesuit Retreat House in Barrington, IL.

TUITION & FEES PAYMENT:

Beginning with the 2022-2023 school year, Providence Catholic High School has partnered with FACTS Management Company to help us manage our tuition payment program. We are excited to be working with FACTS and are confident this program will offer greater efficiency and convenience for families to pay tuition and fees. Links to the 2022-2023 transportation brochure and contract are below. All bus contracts must be received by the transportation company no later than June 15, 2022, so that students may be routed. Providence Catholic cannot guarantee a bus route for contracts received after June 15, 2022.

Please remember that the bus contract is for one full year; once turned in to us it cannot be cancelled. The bus contract deadline allows us to be better prepared to provide bus service at the beginning of the school year. We try to schedule bus pickups after 6:30 a.m., but this depends on the distance from Providence Catholic. Please read the brochure governing the bus program and bus routes. Providence Transportation has the final authority on the time and location of bus pick-ups and drop-offs.


